The report was received from a third party friend of a female called born who was receiving SNAP CHAT messages from regards allegations of a rape.

We attended the LOCOMOTIVE bar at 0240 hours and the front doors were locked and secure and the premises looked closed, the interior lights were on PC GOULD knocked on the door and a male came to the door who provided his name as being born

PC GOULD was able to view inside the location from the entrance door which had been unlocked by
